Spending those countless hours in the summer sun selling tomatoes and rutabagas gave them plenty of time to think, and the figurative seeds of the future were planted.

Elana and Leo purchased and transformed 'Smoothies', a yogurt joint on the main strip in Invermere. The yogurt paraphernalia was quickly replaced with a cappuccino machine and, in the summer of 1993, the Blue Dog Café first opened its doors. It provided great quality food as well as warm, genuine service. The funky little spot set the tone for both Elana and Leo's ongoing commitment to creating an experience like no other. Although the Blue Dog Café grew incredibly popular, both Elana and Leo became victims of their own success. After two years of very long hours, enormous stress, a complete lack of personal time and an offer on the table, they decided to sell the Blue Dog Café. They then took a year off to go travel and see the world.

"What are you two schmucks going to do with your lives? Sell coffee from your garage?!"

This taunt from Elana's mother in 1996 may well have been the kick-start she and Leo needed to embrace Kicking Horse Coffee

as their livelihood. Because the two young entrepreneurs did, in fact, do just that.

From the beginning, Kicking Horse Coffee focused on roasting small batches of premium specialty coffee and packaging coffee the same day to maintain freshness. By roasting small batches, selling whole beans – rather than ground coffee – and using state-of-the-art packaging, Kicking Horse Coffee ensured quality control and consistency of product. As freshness was (...and still is) the highest priority, customers know that each package of coffee opened will be as fresh as the day it was roasted.

Why Fair Trade?

It would be naive to believe there isn't a gap between the 'have' and 'have not' countries in our world. Recognizing this imbalance long ago changed our outlook on life and business. We know what can - and should - be done. The Fair Trade model is by no means perfect nor is it the only answer. But it does make a difference.
